
SIR FRANCIS POWELL

Sir Francis Powell came to live in Dunoon in 1857 and was mainly inspired by the Scottish waters. For his contribution and hard work to the art he was appointed president of the royal Scottish Watercolour Society. Powell is considered one of the best water colourists of his time and Castle House Museum is fortunate to have one of his Dunoon paintings in its collection within the Victorian parlour. The painting is of the town looking along the esplanade from the East Bay area.
